## CURATOR'S CORNER

The Logan County Historical Society and History Center will have a 0.25 mill replacement operating levy on the May 6, 2025, ballot. The 5-year levy would help the Society and History Center continue to better serve and educate the people of Logan County through exhibits, school tours, special events, publications, historic presentations and much more.

The 0.25 mill replacement levy will cost the homeowners very little money. A resident whose home is valued at \*100,000 will probably pay around \*9 per year. As our levy slogan goes, "It Costs So Little To Save So Much!"

The passing of the levy is also necessary for the History Center to continue to be open year-round (seven days a week between office & museum hours), employ a professional staff and continue the upkeep and improvement of the History Center's 1906 Orr Mansion, the Logan County Museum and the Logan County Transportation Museum.

The levy would also make it possible for the Society to continue its many programs and projects and develop new ones. The Society offers a variety of programs including bimonthly meetings, speeches to groups, school tours and programs (nearly 1,000 students in the 2023–2024 school year and over 150 hours of local history instruction) and much more. The Historical Society is very proud of its relationship with area schools and the role it plays in the students' education.

It would be impossible for us to include all that the Logan County Historical Society and History Center provides for the people of Logan County. The support from the citizens of Logan County in the past has made it possible for the Logan County History Center to become one of the most respected county historical society museums in the state. The county's support through the operating levy is truly exceptional and greatly appreciated. We hope you will once again support us on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (EARLY VOTING BEGINS ON APRIL  $8^{TH}$ , 2025).

We need our members' help to pass the levy:

- Please talk to your neighbors, friends, co-workers and family about the importance of the Historical Society and the levy.
- Better yet bring them to the History Center so they can see first-hand what we are doing.
- Help us by placing a levy sign in your yard and asking friends to do the same. (You can pick signs up at the History Center)
- We also need help locating and getting permission to place levy signs in high traffic areas throughout the county.
- And of course, we hope you will vote YES on the levy!



JUNE 18<sup>TH</sup> 2025 – 6:30PM | 664<sup>TH</sup> Air Force/NADRM Museum Tour Ohio Hi-Point Career Center | 2280 St Rt 540 Bellefontaine, OH 43311

Our June Society meeting will be held at the 664<sup>th</sup> Air Force/NADRM (National Air Defense Radar Museum) Museum. Robert Walker, Chairman of the 664<sup>th</sup> Reunion Committee and caretaker of the museum, will give a tour of the museum that is housed in one of the former FPS 26 radar towers.

Logan County played an important role for the United States during the Cold War. In 1951, the United States Air Force opened the 664<sup>th</sup> Aircraft Control & Warning System on Campbell Hill, the highest point in Ohio, just east of Bellefontaine. The 52.7-acre airbase was part of the U.S. Air Defense Command that monitored the skies for enemy planes and air attacks. The 664<sup>th</sup> A.C. & W. Air Force base operated in Bellefontaine from 1951–1969.

The 664<sup>th</sup>/NADRM Museum is keeping the history of the 664<sup>th</sup> airbase and its members alive with a wide variety of priceless memorabilia from the 664<sup>th</sup>. The museum is packed full of photos, radar equipment, uniforms, publications, and much more.
